WHAT WE DO

The STEM Bridge Project is a pathway program designed to support academically talented and low-income students transferring from Pima Community College into the University of Arizona to pursue STEM (Science, Math, Engineering, Technology) degrees.

WHO WE SERVE

This grant has served **three cohorts totaling 98 students** since 2020 with National Science Foundation support.






